Admission is competitive to all VSA 101 courses. Faculty in the respective professional schools will make most admissions decisions. The ideal 101 Series applicant will have a strong interest in the field indicated, will be exceptionally mature, will post high scores on college board exams, and have excellent grades in high school coursework and any listed prerequisites.

We encourage students to select recommenders who can speak to the student's interest in the indicated field. Ask your recommenders to give you their letters in sealed envelopes which they have signed across the seal.

Limited need-based financial assistance is available. Financial aid application is available in current VSA catalog and online at www.pty.vanderbilt.edu. If you are applying for financial assistance, submit your financial aid application and documents along with your application for admission. All are due by March 13, 2009.

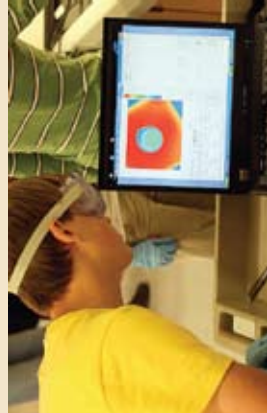
